**MARCHESI VINEYARDS AWARDED 'BEST OF CLASS'
AT PREMIERE 2014 SAN FRANCISCO WINE COMPETITION**

Marchesi Vineyards' 2012 Sangiovese Emma was awarded 'Best of Class' at the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, proclaimed the "Largest Wine Competition of American wines in the World", earlier this month.

The San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition was held in Sonoma County, California. The judges, consisting of 55 professional wine experts within the media, restaurant and hospitality, winemaking and retail wine industries, evaluated the entries. The SFCWC broke the records with a staggering 5,825 wines this year, making it the largest judging held in North America. About 1500 wineries from 25 states entered this competition. Award winning wines is phrased in almost every winery, however, there should be a distinction for Top Awards at Major Wine Competitions and Marchesi Vineyards is clearly in that league.
